## Ocean State Veterinary Specialists ECC Residency – Jan. or July 2020 Start

Ocean State Veterinary Specialists is offering a January start residency in Emergency and Critical Care. OSVS has a very busy ER, and the emergency service manages the majority of the inpatients in the hospital. Residents have the opportunity to see a diverse and challenging caseload, as well as learn to mentor and support interns and emergency doctors.

OSVS is a 26,000sf building, with specialists in internal medicine, surgery, radiology, critical care, neurology, cardiology, oncology, ophthalmology, clinical pathology, and avian/exotics. There are over 20 full time emergency doctors, as well as a strong intern program. Equipment includes digital radiography, CT, MRI, ultrasound, an in-house laboratory, 4-patient telemetry for EKG, mechanical ventilation and more.

There are two criticalists in support of this residency, and a commitment to high quality didactic learning as well as strong supervision for case management. Residents are well prepared for boards (high first-time pass rate), as well as to be very capable clinical criticalists – able to run an ER, supervise interns and residents, and manage the most critical of patients.

We are located in Rhode Island, the beautiful Ocean State – and close to all of New England's offerings. The caseload at OSVS is high – and the cases challenging. But the residents have all of the support and resources they need to provide excellent care. If you are interested in this program, a visit is strongly encouraged.
